Animal Biology and Conservation, Part II of IZDA Compendiums

A new compendium of publications from Indian Zoos, on Animal Biology and Conservation has been brought out. This is Volume II of an ongoing project to compile articles from diverse magazines and journals which have not been available to Indian zoo personnel. These are scientific articles relating to the activities and animals in Indian zoos over a period spanning decades. This series is published by the Indian Zoo Directors' Association and the Central Zoo Authority with funds from CZA.

These articles, which have been divided into three categories for Mammals, Birds and Reptiles, had been published in various magazines and journals both in India and abroad, including the British Journal of Hertetology, the International Zoo Yearbook, Tiger Paper, Bulletin of the Zoological Survey of India, Journal of the Bombay Natural History, Society, Animal Keepers' Forum, Indian Forester and others. Many of these were unavailable to most of the zoo personnel since their publication and, due to the passage of time, even now. Having so much information collected in one handy reference is practically like having a whole library of zoo information at one's disposal.

Volume I of this project, published previously along the same lines as Volume II concerns Health and Disease management.
